Division 22 had a food drive competition between all 12 schools that went really well and all food items collected were later donated to a local homeless shelter/food pantry in the division.

What worked or went well?: The Lieutenant Governors that were present before opening session to assist in setting up and were also there to go over the last minute script changes made the rally go smoothly. It also helped that during lunch 2 out of the 3 lieutenant governors went to the auditorium to go over closing session. It helped that schools had a more reasons to go that motivated them rather than the typical threats of not getting awards if they don't attend.

What would you do differently?: The main thing I would do differently is that I would have all Lieutenant Governors at the rally at least an hour before so they can set up and run though the scripts at least twice. Afterwards they can go mingle with their clubs and help promote better club relations. Also if someone would like to add to the script they should discuss it

with the other Lieutenant Governors and get their approval. I would like to see more communication between all three of us and being more open about ideas when contributing. When meeting to discuss and plan KCKC that we try to work diligently rather than constantly going off topic. I would like to meet more often or have a conference call so we can go over scripts prior to the event as oppose to start practicing the day of. I also believe it would help to create a spreadsheet that will clearly state what each person's assignments are, so no confusing on what one is doing or someone gets stuck doing nothing. Be more understanding and appreciative of each other in regards to manners.
