B. G. HAROLD MARTIN FELLOWSHIP: This is awarded to adults for their unselfish dedication and commitment to the Florida District of Key Club. Their time, efforts, and financial resources have helped provide a quality Key Club experience for students. Nominees may include parents, Faculty Advisors, Kiwanis Advisors, other deserving Kiwanians, Key Club Committee Members, and qualifying CKI members. Up to four recipients are awarded annually. A recipient may not receive the award more than once.
