- ⇒ Confirmation of registration will be sent to the email address provided on this form, on or before June 1, 2019. (If an email address is not provided or is invalid, a confirmation will be sent via the US Postal Service.)
- \Rightarrow All convention attendees must stay at the ICON hotel(s).
- ⇒ Do not submit this form after May 20, 2019. There are no refunds once registration and fees have been submitted. Same gender substitutions may be allowed.
- ⇒ All attendees will receive with their confirmation a Code of Conduct Form and a Medical Release Form. Both forms will need to be completed, signed, and returned to the address below, as soon as possible.
- ⇒ Adults are not permitted to share rooms with students, unless they are the student's parent or legal quardian.
- ⇒ Those wishing to share rooms must submit their registration forms together. The District will assist in finding roommates, however once the rooms are assigned, those assignments are final.
