Create Committees!

Committees are a great way to divide work in your club. It gives members an opportunity to work in groups on accomplishing a specific goal. Designate committee chairs to lead their groups in accomplishing their assigned goals.

Appoint Class Directors!

Class Directors are a liaison between club members and the club's board. They communicate from club officers to the members and vice versa. The Class Director roll allows for members to assume responsibility within their club and lead their grade level in service.
