Service Projects:

-Making Dog Toys for the Animal Shelter: We made Dog Toys out of old T Shirts that were donated by members and Chiles Key Club

-Notes to Troops: We wrote letters to our American Troops

Icebreakers:

-"Can I Join your group?": 4 volunteers go in the four corners of the room and write a physical attribute about themselves on a note card, then everyone in the room walks around asking "Can I join your group?" And if the person asking has the physical attribute they can join, if not, they move on. There will be a group left over that has no where to belong. We then had a talk about inclusiveness and how it felt to be rejected, and how you should never do that as a key clubber.

-"Keep 'em Up!" : We split the crowd into 7 equally populated groups and gave the whole group 4 balloons--each balloon had a core value of Key Club on it--and the whole group then tried keep up the balloons by just hitting the balloons in the air. I then had other LTGs and adults go around and take kids out of the groups, making it smaller and smaller, until there was one person left, struggling to hold up all four. We then explained how it is possible for one individual to uphold the values of Key Club; however, it is much easier when a whole club does it. So we talked about how a whole club should work together to keep these values alive in their respective schools.

What worked or went well?: The first thing that helped significantly increased people was the aspect of free food. Then we got everyone excited by introducing our new divisional mascot, Buster the Bear, and we gave him out in the same way the spirit stick is given out: by club during roll call. We then had the Bigger than you powerpoint to introduce everyone to Key Club, had two great icebreakers, then introduced them to Circle K and The Governors project. It was actually really great to have Circle K members (we had 5 CKI members here). Showing one of the new Eliminate Project videos worked very well. Then having the service projects after also made the division closer.

What would you do differently?: If I could do it differently, I would definitely tried to confirm with more people, as we had a little overestimate in the amount of attendance.
