Kubra: The pancakes were cheap and simple! Having a meeting 1 week prior to Spring Zone Rally discussing where workshop rooms will be and technology issues that may occur. Checking all the technology 2 hours before rally started and having backup resources if technology failed. Lauren: I think that serving breakfast was a great idea. It was cheap and people seemed to

enjoy it. The one workshop session went well since people seemed to be happier with the idea of the rally being shorter than usual.

What would you do differently?: Leah: The only thing I would change would be the time the event started so early in the morning due to far travels for a lot of club which certainly effected our attendence. I understand there were two SZR the same day which would be something to look out for next year. Michael: I would ensure that all mic's are working properly. Charli: Microphones could be checked earlier and technicalities needed to be worked out. Kathryn: I think that we need to make sure there is enough time for both the workshop AND the DCM/election. This year it was very tight on time. We also need to do a microphone check as we had issues with that too. Timing was also a little off this year, we were put behind schedule so speakers were rearranged, etc. The host club president also needs to be more involved, we should not be having to hunt people down. Shane: limited DCM time due to elections-- could have used more time, more strategic caucusing schedule (based on division room locations) also would have been beneficial to candidates. Kubra: Making sure the mic was working and practice the script day of the Rally. Lauren: We had a tech guy which we great, but next time I think we such have him verify that our microphone works and stay a little while into the rally/ workshop sessions in case an issue arises.
