Kathryn: we need someone to go around and show end time for workshops - many ran over and people were late to their next workshop, video feed, more Kiwanians speaking. Shane: ensure that the tech is working. Kubra: check all the technology in all the rooms. Amanda: many of the "what went wrong" issues was with Keiser. 
