What would you do differently?:

Eileen: Master script should be kept in a binder and add in "please be seated" to script to not have people standing around and to start on time

Noah: Planning it on a long weekend and having lunch before closing session. Ten minutes short on opening session because of no instruction to sit down. Have an LTG in charge of starting on time and timing

Ruben: Not enough people directing traffic; have host school present the day before and have signs posted

Jose: Workshops started way too late; have extra time for opening session and start on time; registration should be more than 30 minutes (45 minutes is ideal); have registration closer to session locations

Griffin: Closing session was empty and workshops; schedule more time for whole rally (30 minutes); verify lunch delivery; advertise ending time

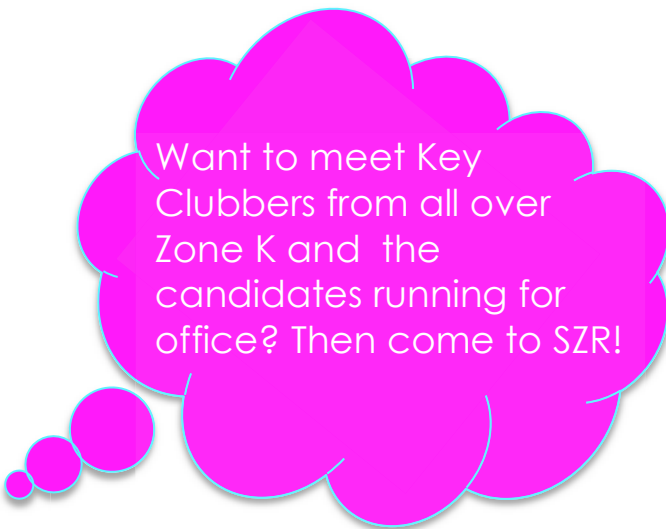
